HAVING REGARD TO file EX-2026-43755670- -APN-DGD#MS, Law No. 26,687, Decree No. 602 dated May 28, 2013, Ministry of Health Resolutions Nos. 1124 dated August 4, 2006, 497 dated April 17, 2012, as amended, and 549 dated April 30, 2026, and

WHEREAS:

Article 23 of the Ministries Act No. 22,520 (Consolidated Text: Decree No. 438/1992), as amended, establishes the authority over all matters pertaining to public health and the promotion of healthy behaviors within the community, empowering this Ministry to exercise public health authority with respect to health-related products, technologies, equipment, instruments, and procedures; to take preventive action to reduce morbidity caused by toxic substances and chemical hazards at all stages of the life cycle; and to develop plans aimed at the prevention and detection of endemic and noncommunicable diseases.

Ministry of Health Resolution No. 1124/2006 established the NATIONAL TOBACCO CONTROL PROGRAM with the objective, among others, of keeping the prevalence of tobacco use low through measures that prevent people from starting to smoke and promote cessation among current smokers.

Law No. 26,687 regulates the advertising, promotion, and consumption of tobacco products for the purposes of prevention and assistance to the population in the face of the harms caused by smoking.

Article 10 of the aforementioned Law provides that the packaging and containers of tobacco products must include a graphic health warning and a message describing the harmful effects of consuming tobacco products, in accordance with the list set forth in Article 7 of the same Law; it also provides, in the aforementioned Article 10, that these messages must be updated periodically by the enforcement authority.

Article 12 of the same Law establishes that packages and containers of tobacco products must include, on one (1) of their sides, information regarding the free smoking cessation service, telephone number, and website provided by the MINISTRY OF HEALTH.

Article 27 of Law No. 26,687 establishes that the MINISTRY OF HEALTH is the authority responsible for enforcing said law.

Article 7 of Appendix I to Decree No. 602/13, which implements the aforementioned Law, authorizes the MINISTRY OF HEALTH to determine the rotation of public health messages, to expand or modify the list of public health messages, to design them, and to determine the pictograms or images corresponding to each message.

By Resolutions No. 497/2012, No. 494/2014, No. 2236/2015, No. 623/2019, and No. 3499/2021, this MINISTRY OF HEALTH approved the “Graphic Regulations on the Packaging, Sale, and Consumption of Tobacco Products” and its subsequent updates.

In order to comply with the provisions of Article 7 of the aforementioned Regulatory Decree, Appendix I of Resolution No. 497/2012 states that “Packaging and containers for tobacco products shall include an image and a health warning describing the harmful effects of consuming tobacco products (...) shall be updated by the enforcement authority at intervals of no more than two (2) years and no less than one (1) year.” Furthermore, pursuant to the newly approved regulations, it is necessary to update the graphic standards for the packaging of tobacco and nicotine products, establishing new content and formats for health warnings.

Article 23 of Law No. 26,687 establishes a ban on smoking in certain enclosed spaces, and its Regulatory Decree, for its part, specifies that this ban covers smoking or holding a lit tobacco product or any other smoking product listed in Article 3 of the aforementioned Regulatory Decree, as well as those that, due to their essential characteristics, are analogous to them. This is so because it has been the intent of the Executive Branch to expressly state that the list provided therein is illustrative, insofar as the final portion of the aforementioned article indicates “without in any way being exhaustive or limiting other products that meet these conditions.”

Pursuant to Article 25 of the aforementioned Law and the Decree regulating it, signs must be posted informing the public of the smoking ban in areas where such a ban is in effect, with the enforcement authority responsible for determining the wording of the signs, as well as the telephone number and email address designated for receiving complaints regarding noncompliance.

Ministry of Health Resolution No. 549/2026 repealed the corresponding Resolution No. 565/2023, which prohibited the importation, distribution, sale, advertising, and any form of promotion or sponsorship throughout Argentine territory of electronic systems or devices intended for inhaling tobacco vapors or aerosols, commonly referred to as “Heated Tobacco Products,” including all types of accessories intended for the operation of such systems or devices, as well as tobacco cartridges and sticks to be heated in such systems. Instead, such resolution established a new regulatory framework for the marketing of tobacco and nicotine products that are alternatives to conventional cigarettes, with clear and predictable health and technical rules.

In its capacity as the enforcement authority, pursuant to the regulatory powers established in the legislation and the corresponding regulatory decrees, it is deemed necessary to include an express reference to the prohibition on the use of e-cigarettes and heated tobacco products in places where smoking is prohibited.

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Article 26 of Law No. 26,687 provides that the enforcement authority shall establish at least one (1) toll-free telephone number and one (1) email address, which must be publicized through the mass media and prominently displayed at points of sale for tobacco products and in places where their consumption is prohibited, in order to facilitate the filing of complaints regarding noncompliance with the provisions set forth therein.

Given the emergence of new forms of communication, this Ministry has updated and expanded the communication channels provided for in the aforementioned Article 26, incorporating a chatbot available through the WhatsApp instant messaging app aimed at the general public and, in particular, at all those seeking and/or requiring information on health issues related to smoking, including, inter alia, strategies for quitting smoking and instructions on how to file a complaint regarding non-compliance with current regulations.

Article 32 of the aforementioned Law establishes penalties for violations of its provisions.

Regulatory Decree No. 602/2013, in relation to Article 32 of the Law, provides that liability for noncompliance and the corresponding penalties shall fall primarily on the manufacturers or importers of tobacco products, and in cases of noncompliance with Chapter II of the Act, the penalties shall fall secondarily on the individuals or legal entities that produce or publish such content for the media and on the media outlets themselves that provide the service.

The aforementioned article establishes that the enforcement authority may request the cooperation of national agencies and the competent bodies of provincial and local jurisdictions in order to ensure oversight and compliance with the provisions of the law regarding the packaging of products made with tobacco and nicotine.

Article 10 of Appendix I to Decree No. 602, dated May 28, 2013, establishes that the new health warnings and their respective pictograms or images must be made available to manufacturers and importers no later than SIX (6) months prior to their effective date.

Considering the approval of new graphic regulations for health warnings applicable to products containing tobacco and nicotine, and given that products covered by Ministry of Health Resolution No. 549/2026 must comply with these requirements in order to be marketed, it is necessary to harmonize the implementation deadlines for both regulatory regimes.

Accordingly, the deadline for implementing Ministry of Health Resolution No. 549/2026 should be extended to ensure that the affected products are properly brought into compliance.

The NATIONAL TOBACCO CONTROL PROGRAM and the NATIONAL DIRECTORATE FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE MANAGEMENT OF NONCOMMUNICABLE DISEASES have taken action within the scope of their respective authorities.

The UNDERSECRETARIAT FOR HEALTH PLANNING AND PROGRAMMING and the SECRETARIAT FOR HEALTH MANAGEMENT have given their approval.

The GENERAL DIRECTORATE OF LEGAL AFFAIRS has acted within its jurisdiction.

This action is taken in exercise of the powers arising from the Law on Ministries No. 22,520, Law No. 26,687, and its Regulatory Decree No. 602/2013. Therefore, THE MINISTER OF HEALTH

RESOLVES:

ARTICLE 1: Ministry of Health Resolutions Nos. 623 of April 1, 2019, and 3499 of December 6, 2021, are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE 2: Appendix I of Ministry of Health Resolution No. 497 of April 23, 2012, with IF-2026-64902249-APN-DNAIENT#MS, which forms an integral part of this resolution under the title APPENDIX I “HEALTH WARNINGS FOR TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS.”

ARTICLE 3: APPENDIX II, “GRAPHIC REGULATIONS FOR TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS,” approved by Ministry of Health Resolution No. 497 of April 23, 2012, is hereby repealed.

ARTICLE 4: This Resolution, together with its APPENDIX I, shall be published on the website of the MINISTRY OF HEALTH.

ARTICLE 5: This measure shall be implemented within the time frame established by Article 10 of CHAPTER III of APPENDIX I to Decree No. 602/2013.

ARTICLE 6: The implementation period established in Article 5 of Ministerial Resolution No. 549 of April 30, 2026, is hereby extended for a period of up to ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY (180) days, effective as of the date this measure enters into force.

ARTICLE 7: This resolution shall be communicated, published, forwarded to the NATIONAL DIRECTORATE OF THE OFFICIAL REGISTER, and filed.

APPENDIX I: “HEALTH WARNINGS FOR CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS.”

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Section 1

HEALTH WARNINGS FOR CIGARETTES AND COMBUSTIBLE TOBACCO PRODUCTS

As required by Law 26,687, there are 10 health warnings for cigarettes and combustible tobacco products. The 6th Series of Health Warnings retains most of the existing health warnings, adding the phrase “Smoking tobacco...” to the back of the package, along with the following ten corresponding statements: 1. Causes cancer, 2. Causes COPD, 3. Causes heart attacks, 4. Causes strokes, 5. Causes asthma attacks, 6. Puts your baby at risk during pregnancy, 7. Causes blindness, 8. Increases the risk of diabetes, 9. Causes oral diseases, and 10. Seriously pollutes the environment.

a) In the advertising and promotion of cigarettes and combustible tobacco products:

In all cases, advertising or promotion of tobacco products must include the warning pictogram: **SMOKING TOBACCO INCREASES THE RISK OF DIABETES/TOBACCO USE AGGRAVATES VASCULAR DAMAGE CAUSED BY DIABETES**, with the text printed in a legible font, prominent, and proportionate within a rectangle with a white background and black text, and must occupy twenty percent (20%) of the total surface area of the material being advertised or promoted, in accordance with the format and typography detailed in the section titled **GRAPHIC REGULATIONS FOR CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS** of this document.

This pictogram shall be located adjacent to and contiguous with the right or bottom side of the health warning and shall have proportions similar to those of the warning.

b) On packs of cigarettes and combustible tobacco products

Packs and containers of cigarettes, roll-your-own tobacco, and other combustible tobacco products shall include one of the 10 available health warnings, which consist of an image and a health message describing the harmful effects of consuming tobacco products. Each health warning and its corresponding image in the section titled “**GRAPHIC REGULATIONS FOR CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS**” of this document shall be printed on every individual retail package and container of tobacco products, in accordance with the corresponding graphic specifications.

The health warning must be written in **ONE (1)** black rectangle on a white background with black lettering and must occupy the bottom **FIFTY PERCENT (50%)** of **ONE (1)** of the main exposed surfaces. The image must occupy the bottom **FIFTY PERCENT (50%)** of the other main surface.

The manufacturer or importer must adapt the provided templates to the dimensions of the packaging without altering its proportions or graphic characteristics.

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In the case of cigarette cartons or other packaging with similar characteristics, the image shall be printed on the main side most visible to the consumer, occupying one of the surfaces resulting from dividing the area of that side in half along its longest side. The warning message shall also be printed on the opposite side.

In the case of cylindrical packaging, it shall be considered to have a single main side, and the proportions shall be maintained, with 25% of that surface area allocated to the image and 25% to the warning message.

Packages of products made with tobacco for smoking and accessories must include, printed on one (1) of their sides, the following information ABOUT THE FREE SERVICE TO QUIT NICOTINE IN ANY OF ITS FORMS OFFERED BY THE NATIONAL MINISTRY OF HEALTH, which is available in the section titled GRAPHIC REGULATIONS FOR CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS in this document.

The information will be displayed within a rectangle with a black background and white text. If the shape of the package or container does not have sides, the information must, in all cases, be legible and occupy an area of no less than six percent (6%) of the total surface area of the packaging.

Distribution: Manufacturers of tobacco products shall release their units to the market, ensuring the uniform and simultaneous distribution of the 10 health warnings and images. Uniform distribution shall be understood to mean the proportional distribution of tobacco product units at points of sale throughout the entire national territory.

The importer of the tobacco product shall be responsible for compliance with this provision in the case of packaging and containers of products imported from abroad.

c) At points of sale

All points of sale for cigarettes and smokable tobacco products must display the warning pictogram regarding the harm caused by smoking in relation to diabetes: SMOKING TOBACCO INCREASES THE RISK OF DIABETES / TOBACCO USE AGGRAVATES VASCULAR DAMAGE CAUSED BY DIABETES.

Section 2:

HEALTH WARNINGS FOR OTHER TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS.

Resolution 549/26 brings new tobacco products under the scope of Law 26687, thereby requiring them to display a graphic health warning that describes the harmful effects of consuming products made with tobacco or nicotine. Since these are new products on the market and the only thing they have in common is the presence of nicotine—a highly addictive substance—it is proposed that electronic cigarettes, vapers, and vaping devices (E-cigarettes) liquid solutions for these devices; heated tobacco products (HTPs), sticks for these products, and nicotine pouches (NPs) will carry a single health warning: THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS NICOTINE, WHICH IS HIGHLY ADDICTIVE.

a) In the advertising and promotion of electronic cigarettes, vapers, and vaping devices (e-cigarettes); liquid solutions for these; heated tobacco products (HTPs); sticks; and nicotine pouches (NPs):

In all cases, the advertising or promotion of electronic cigarettes, vapers, and vaping devices (e-cigarettes); liquid solutions for these devices; heated tobacco products (HTPs); sticks; and nicotine pouches (NP) must include the health warning “THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS NICOTINE, WHICH IS HIGHLY ADDICTIVE.” This text must be printed in a legible font, prominent, and proportionate within a rectangle with a white background and black text, which must occupy twenty percent (20%) of the total surface area of the material being advertised or promoted, in accordance with the format and typography detailed in the section titled GRAPHIC REGULATIONS FOR CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS of this document.

This pictogram shall be located adjacent to and contiguous with the right or bottom side of the health warning and shall have proportions similar to those of the warning.

b) On packaging for electronic cigarettes, vapes, and vaping devices (E-cigarettes) and the liquid solutions used with them; heated tobacco products (HTPs) and sticks; and nicotine pouches (NPs):

The health warning and its corresponding image shall describe the harms associated with these products: “THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS NICOTINE, WHICH IS HIGHLY ADDICTIVE” shall be printed on each individual retail package of these products, in accordance with the corresponding graphic specifications.

The health warning will be written in ONE (1) black rectangle on a white background with black text and will occupy the bottom FIFTY PERCENT (50%) of ONE (1) of the main exposed surfaces. The graphic will occupy the bottom FIFTY PERCENT (50%) of the other main surface.

The manufacturer or importer must adapt the provided templates to the packaging dimensions without altering their proportions or graphic characteristics.

In the case of cylindrical packaging, it shall be considered to have a single main side, and the proportions must be maintained, with 25% of that surface area reserved for the image and 25% for the text.

Packages of products containing tobacco or nicotine and accessories must include the following information printed on one (1) of their sides REGARDING THE FREE SERVICE TO QUIT USING NICOTINE IN ANY OF ITS FORMS OFFERED BY THE NATIONAL MINISTRY OF HEALTH, which is available in the section titled GRAPHIC REGULATIONS FOR CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS in this document:

The information shall be displayed within a rectangle with a black background and white text, in accordance with the graphic format detailed in Appendix II. If the shape of the package or container does not have sides, the information must, in all cases, be legible and occupy an area of no less than six percent (6%) of the total surface area of the packaging.

The manufacturer must include the registration number issued by the Ministry of Health on the packaging, in accordance with the provisions of Ministry of Health Resolution No. 549/26, which is available in the section titled GRAPHIC REGULATIONS FOR CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS.

It shall be the responsibility of the importer of tobacco products to ensure compliance with this provision in the case of packaging and containers for products imported from abroad.

c) At points of sale

All points of sale for other tobacco or nicotine products must display the warning pictogram:
THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS NICOTINE, WHICH IS HIGHLY ADDICTIVE.

Section 3:

SIGNS FOR CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS

a) At points of sale:

Inside establishments selling products made from tobacco or nicotine, as well as at points of sale, distribution, and delivery of any kind, ONE (1) sign measuring no less than TWENTY (20) centimeters on each side must be displayed in a visible location, in black letters on a white background, bearing the following text as set forth in APPENDIX II:

THE SALE, DISTRIBUTION, PROMOTION, OR DELIVERY, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, OF PRODUCTS CONTAINING TOBACCO OR NICOTINE TO MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18, IS PROHIBITED.

b) In places where smoking, vaping, or using a heated tobacco product is prohibited:

In places where smoking, vaping, or using a heated tobacco product is prohibited, signs indicating such prohibition must be posted.

The relevant message must be written legibly and prominently on signs no smaller than THIRTY (30) centimeters on each side, placed in a visible location, in black letters on a white background. The signs shall contain the following text in accordance with the format available in the section titled GRAPHIC REGULATIONS FOR CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS.

TOBACCO SMOKE- AND EMISSION-FREE ENVIRONMENT. SMOKING, VAPING, AND THE USE OF HEATED TOBACCO PRODUCTS ARE PROHIBITED.

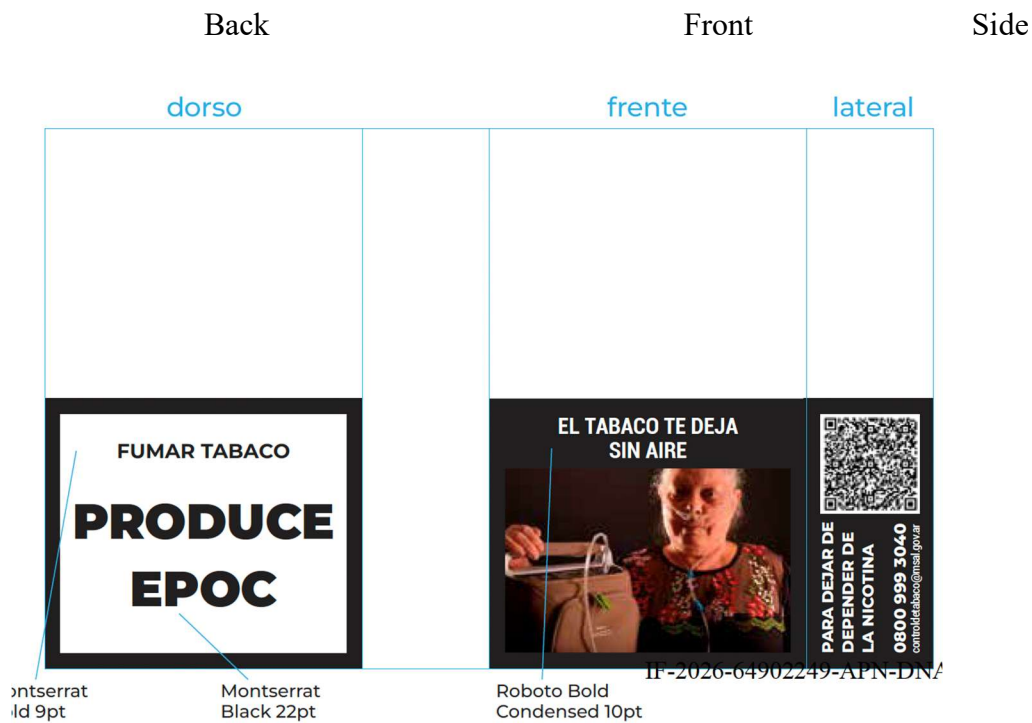

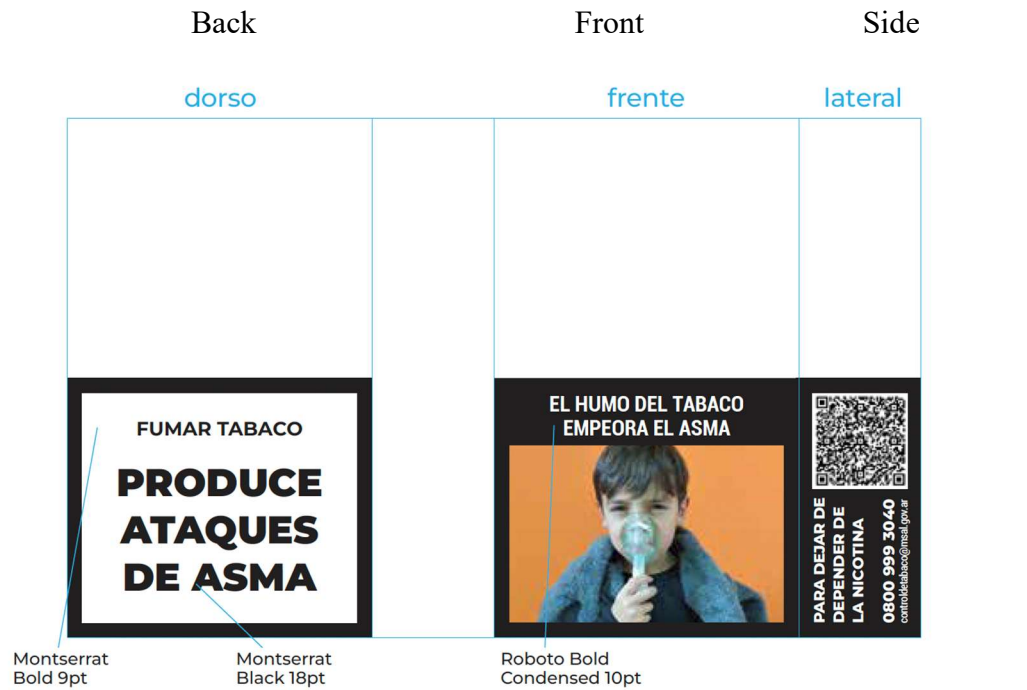

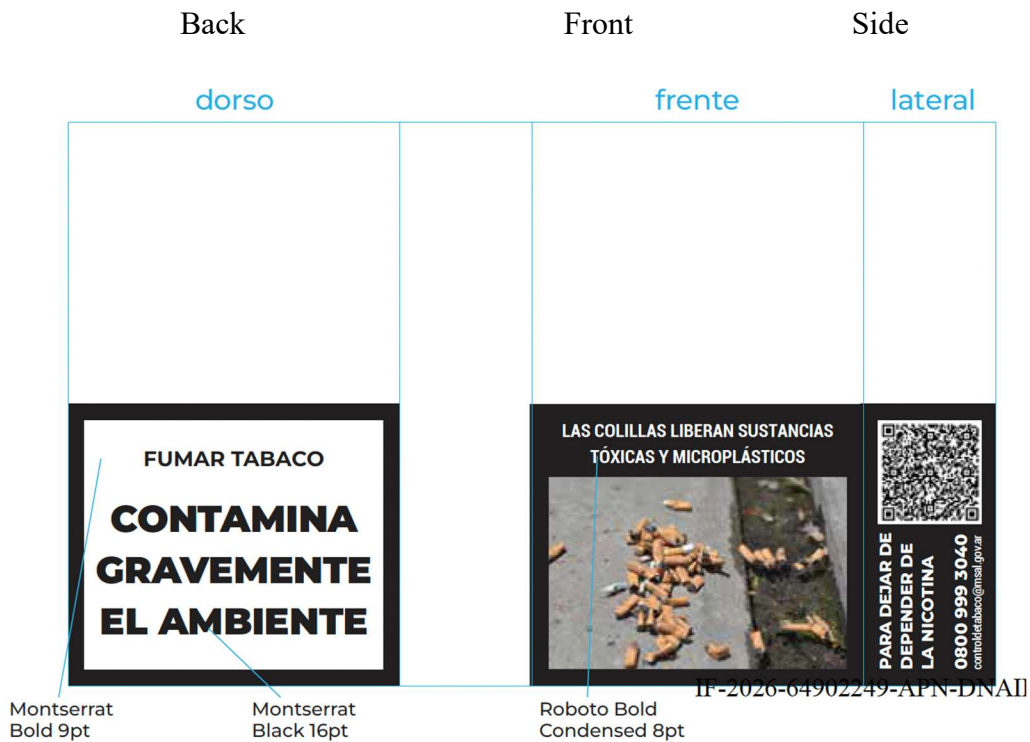

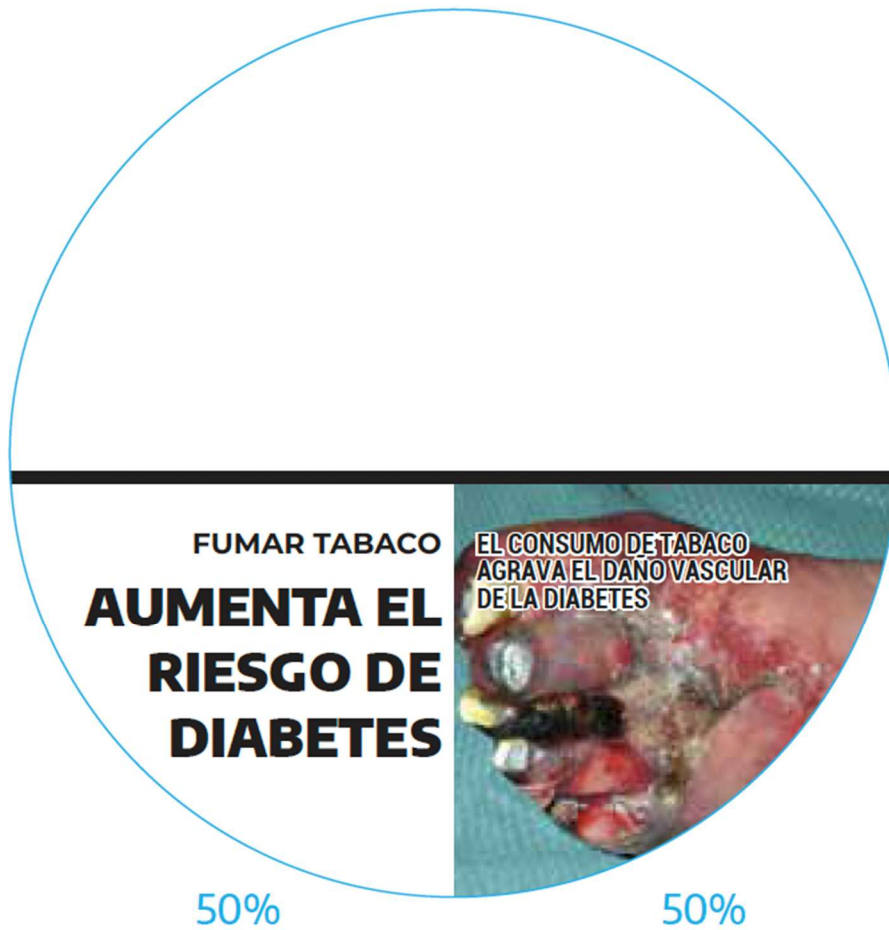
