CIRCULAR ON

Smoking Ban at workplaces and within the compound of Angkor temple sites

Ref. Circular of the Council of Ministers No.1270 SCN.AV dated 19 August, 1194 on Smoke Free Policy in civil servants' workplaces, meeting rooms, and theaters.

Smoking cigarettes does not only cause harmful effects on the health of smokers as well as secondhand smoke but it also destroys environment especially it causes forest fire. To contribute to the health of staff, civil servants, visitors, and to protect environment of Angkor Tourism sites, APSARA Authority hereby provides the following guidance to institutions under its control and relevant companies:

- 1. No smoking in all offices and workplaces of civil servants of APSARA Authority and within the compound of temple sites.
- 2. All offices and workplaces of civil servants and within the compound of the temple sites shall carry smoking ban signs.
- 3. Widely disseminate the guidance on smoking ban to civil servants, staff of relevant companies, visitors, and all people to ensure the effectiveness of this circular implementation.
- 4. In case if there is someone smoking in the compound of the temple sites , officials, staff, and competent persons working in the compound of Angkor temple sites shall advise him/her and immediately interrupt his/her smoking.

Up on receiving this circular His Excellencies, Lok Chumteav, Oknha, ladies and gentlemen, the director of institutions under the control of APSARA Authority and owners of relevant companies shall effectively implement this circular from the date of signature.
