2.	The 31st day of May, 2002 is hereby appointed as the day on which Part 2 of the Public Health (Tobacco) Act, 2002 shall come into operation.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation)

This Order appoints the 31st day of May, 2002 as the date for the coming into operation of part 2 of the Public Health (Tobacco) Act, 2002.

Part 2 of the Act provides for the establishment of the Office of Tobacco Control on a statutory basis. The Office of Tobacco Control was established on an administrative basis in 2000. The Office will consist of a chairperson and 11 other members and will have a chief executive officer and staff. Other standard provisions for a statutory body are provided for in Part 2, e.g. functions, meetings, committees, remuneration, superannuation, etc.

Part 2 of the Act also provides for the establishment of the Tobacco Free Council which will be established by the Office.
