## DECREE OF THE MINISTER OF NATIONAL DEFENSE

of 25 May 2000

on regulating the admissibility of the use of tobacco products on the premises of facilities supervised by the Minister of National Defense.

On the basis of article 5 section 3of the law of 9 November 1995 on Protecting the Health from the Adverse Effects of Tobacco and Tobacco Products Use (Journal of Laws 1996 No. 10, item 55, of 1997 No. 88, item 554 and No. 121, item 771, as well as of 1999 No. 96, item 1107), it is decreed as follows:

tobacco products at times and places determined by the daily routine.

§ 3. The decree shall enter into force after 14 days from the date of promulgation.

## § 1.

- 1. At facilities occupied by organizational units of the Ministry of National Defense and the organizational units subordinated to the Minister of National Defense or supervised by him, smoking tobacco products is permissible only in places designated by the directors (officers, commanders) of those units.
- 2. Places where tobacco smoking is permitted shall be designated in a part of a building that precludes tobacco smoke from affecting nonsmokers, in separate and enclosed spaces, and shall be clearly marked.
- 3. Places referred to in section 2 may not be designated in:
- 1) Soldiers' chambers,
- 2) classrooms and other rooms for instruction,
- 3) clubrooms or sports facilities.
- 4. If conditions referred to in section 2 cannot be fulfilled in a building, then places where smoking tobacco products is permitted may be designated outside the facility.
- § 2 In military disciplinary detention centers and detention rooms, it is permissible for soldiers in disciplinary detention and detained soldiers to smoke
